**THE SCIENCE OF SLIME**

**HANDS-ON SCIENCE EXPERIMENT AT HOME!**

## **MATERIALS**

- Bottle of school glue  
(can use colour or glitter glue)
- Contact lens solution  
(must contain boric acid!)
- Baking soda
- Optional: glitter, food colouring or other fun mix-ins!

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

- Add the glue to a large bowl
- Add one teaspoon of baking soda to the bowl and mix well
- Add one tablespoon of contact lens solution and mix well
- You can also add any fun mix-ins like glitter or food colouring to your slime!
- Once the slime starts holding together, knead it by hand
- If the slime is still sticky, add a little more contact lens solution until it reaches a good consistency
